For one school or organisation only. Materials may be used by staff, pupils and families within that organisation.

Multi Organisation Licence

For trusts, groups of schools, or professional providers working across multiple settings. Use is limited to the agreed number of schools or supported organisations.

These Terms and Conditions apply to the website **Wired for Movement** (www.wiredformovement.com), owned and operated by **Wired for Education Ltd** (Company No. 12518129), 63 Bedford Road, Cranfield, Bedfordshire, MK43 0EX, United Kingdom (“we”, “us”, “our”).

Wired for Education Ltd also operates other educational platforms; however, these Terms relate solely to Wired for Movement unless stated otherwise.

By accessing the Website, creating an account, purchasing Products, subscribing to services, or placing orders via card payment or Purchase Order (PO), you agree to be bound by these Terms.

1. Definitions

- **“Website”** means www.wiredformovement.com
- **“Customer”, “you”, “your”** means any individual, school, organisation, trust, company or institution purchasing Products or subscriptions
- **“Products”** means digital downloads, PDFs, games, assessments, intervention programmes, lesson plans and related resources
- **“Subscription”** means time limited access to online content, tools or services on the Website
- **“Licence”** means the limited permission granted to use Products in accordance with these Terms

2. Accounts and Eligibility

You must be at least 18 years old or authorised by your organisation to create an account or make purchases.

You are responsible for maintaining accurate account details and safeguarding login credentials.

Accounts must only be used within the scope of the purchased Licence.

We reserve the right to suspend or terminate accounts for breach of these Terms.

3. Digital Products and Licensing

All Products remain the intellectual property of Wired for Education Ltd and are supplied under licence only.

3.1 Single Organisation / Single School Licence

Unless otherwise stated, purchases include a **Single Organisation Licence**, allowing:

- Downloading and printing of Products
- Use within one named school or organisation only
- Use by employed staff, pupils and caregivers of children currently attending that organisation

This does **not** permit:

- Use across multiple schools or trusts
- Sharing with external providers or organisations
- Public uploading or redistribution

3.2 Multi Organisation / Trust / Professional Use Licence

Where purchased or agreed, a **Multi Organisation Licence** allows:

- Use across multiple schools or organisations as specified
- Use by academy trusts, coaching companies or professional providers within agreed settings

Use is limited strictly to the agreed scope.

Resale, redistribution or use beyond this scope is prohibited.

3.3 General Restrictions

Under all licence types you must not:

- Resell or commercially exploit Products
- Share outside licence permissions
- Upload to public platforms or file sharing services
- Include Products within other paid services

All rights not expressly granted are reserved.

4. Ordering and Payment

4.1 Online Payments

Payments may be made online via card using WooCommerce, Stripe or PayPal.

4.2 Purchase Orders

Approved organisations may purchase via official Purchase Order.

Access may be granted once the PO is accepted. Invoices must be paid within agreed terms.

Failure to pay may result in suspended access.

5. Subscriptions, Term and Renewal (Wired for Movement)

5.1 Subscription Length

Wired for Movement subscriptions operate on a **12 month term** unless stated otherwise.

Access remains active for the duration of the paid term only.

5.2 Automatic Renewal

Where enabled:

- Subscriptions renew annually at the then current rate
- Customers are notified at least 30 days before renewal
- Renewal may be cancelled before the renewal date

5.3 Cancellation

On cancellation:

- Access continues until the end of the current paid term
- No partial refunds for unused periods unless required by law

5.4 Perpetual Access Products

Some Products may be sold as one off purchases with no expiry.

Where stated on the Product listing, access is perpetual, subject to licence restrictions.

5.5 Pricing Changes on Renewal

Subscription fees may change from time to time.

Where a subscription renews, the renewal will be charged at the price displayed on the Website at the time of renewal, unless otherwise agreed in writing.

Customers will be notified of any pricing changes prior to renewal in accordance with Section 5.2.

6. Pricing and VAT

All prices are shown in GBP.

VAT will be applied where legally required once Wired for Education Ltd is VAT registered. Where VAT is not charged, customers may be responsible for any applicable local taxes.

7. Refunds and Cancellations

Digital Products are non refundable once accessed or downloaded, where immediate supply has been consented to.

Refunds will be issued for faulty or mis described Products if notified within 14 days.

Subscription fees are non refundable once a term has begun except where legally required.

8. Intellectual Property

All Content remains the intellectual property of Wired for Education Ltd and/or Monty Olding.

You are granted a limited licence only as described in these Terms.

Copyright and branding must not be removed.

9. Acceptable Use

You must not:

- Disrupt the Website
- Access systems without authorisation
- Use Products outside licence permissions
- Breach any laws or rights of others

- We exclude implied warranties

We are not responsible for third party platforms including payment processors.

Their terms apply.

12. Personal Data

Personal data is processed in line with our Privacy and Cookies Policy.

13. Service Availability

We aim to maintain access but do not guarantee uninterrupted service.

We may suspend or modify services with reasonable notice.

14. Termination

We may suspend or terminate access for breach of these Terms.

Termination does not affect accrued rights or obligations.

15. International Sales and Access

We offer Products and Subscriptions for purchase internationally.

All prices are displayed in GBP. Customers are responsible for any local taxes, duties, or charges applicable in their country where VAT is not applied.

Access requires suitable internet connection and devices. We are not responsible for limitations caused by infrastructure, regulations or service providers outside the United Kingdom.

All licences apply globally and remain subject to the restrictions in these Terms.

16. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

These Terms are governed by the laws of England and Wales.

The courts of England and Wales have exclusive jurisdiction.

Do you sell internationally?

What is a Multi Organisation Licence?

This allows use across multiple schools, trusts or supported settings, such as coaching companies working with several schools.

Use is limited to the agreed number of organisations.

Can we share resources with another school?

No. Sharing outside your licensed organisation or agreed scope is not permitted.

Can we resell or include the resources in our own programmes?

No. All materials remain the property of Wired for Education Ltd and may not be resold or redistributed.

How long does a Wired for Movement subscription last?

Subscriptions run for 12 months and may renew automatically unless cancelled.

What happens if we cancel?

You retain access until the end of the paid term.

Are some products a one off purchase?

Yes. Some standalone products may be purchased with no expiry, subject to licence terms.

Can schools purchase via Purchase Order?

Yes, subject to approval.
